ONSITE LEARNING SUPPORT PLAN

As required by Executive Order 2020-51, 2020-41 and 2020-44, Sonoran Science Academy-East will offer free on-site learning opportunities and support services beginning August 17, 2020.

SERVICES

On-site learning opportunities and support services are not traditional, teacher-led instruction. On-site learning opportunities and support services include a learning space, supervision, and Internet access so that students can participate in the school's teacher-led, distance learning instructional model. The best way to think of this is that it is like a supervised study hall.

On-site learning opportunities provide a quiet, safe, adult-monitored place for:

- Students qualifying under McKinney-Vento
- Students living in foster care
- Students whose parents are essential workers
- Students who have no safe place to go during school hours

In addition, the following student populations will be given priority in the school's on-site support services plan:

- Students meeting the criteria for free/reduced lunch
- Students with an IEP or 504
- Students meeting the criteria for EL (English Learners)

On site learning opportunities will be provided five days a week, during regular school hours.

Families who have the resources to adequately support their students' remote learning at home are asked, wherever possible, to refrain from requesting this capacity-driven service.

Please note: Schools are not required to provide all available support services on-site daily to every student who expresses any need and can optimize resource utilization by ensuring parents/guardians have the opportunity to identify which specific service their student needs.

This school will not limit the availability of, or refuse to provide, free on-site learning opportunities and on-site support services. However, advance registration is **required** so that adequate staffing and

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appropriate safety can be assured. In addition, it is strongly recommended that, where feasible, families take advantage of the school's Distance Learning Plan for students at higher risk of severe illness.

HOURS

On-site learning opportunities and support services are only available during regular school hours. Regular school hours for this campus are:

Monday – Thursday: 8:05 – 3:15

Friday: 8:05 – 12:05

Parents are required to collect their student timely at the end of the regular school day.

LUNCH

Lunch will be available to students. Lunch orders must be placed in advance. Please contact the front office if you have specific questions about lunch ordering.

On Fridays, students who have ordered lunch will be provided a sack lunch upon dismissal.

BEFORE AND AFTER CARE

Before and After Care is available at this school. However, it is not part of the regular school day. Families interested in registering for this fee-based program, run by Champions, should contact: Shawna Cornwall (scornwall@discoverchampions.com) for information.

PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS

1. Parents/guardians must register their student in advance.
2. Parents must notify the front office, in advance, if their student has a health need that requires medication, and will need to follow standard school policies regarding medications.
3. Parents must agree that they and their student will comply with the school's COVID-19 mitigation measures.
4. Parents are required to pick their student up timely at the end of the school day.
5. Students must bring their school-issued Chromebook to campus each day, fully charged.
6. Students must bring personal headphones to school each day.
7. Students are required to comply with normal school rules while on campus, including the wearing of school uniforms.

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
